Lt. Governor Ellspermann Announces Grant Awards
Town of Paoli to receive \$145,260 through OCRA program

Indianapolis – Lt. Governor Sue Ellspermann today announced that the Town of Paoli is receiving a grant for \$145,260 through the Blight Clearance Program managed by the Office of Community and Rural Affairs. Funded by the federal Community Development Block Grant, this program is available to communities for demolition and environmental clearance of blighted properties in the community. Each grant must have a match of local funds and meet certain other grant requirements.

In announcing the grants, Lt. Governor Ellspermann noted, “Indiana’s rural and smaller cities and towns are important to the overall economic and social fabric of our state. Through this specific program and others, we want to help these communities remain attractive places to live, raise families and operate businesses.
