NEW IPL RATE CASE

Indianapolis Power & Light Company (IPL) has recently filed a request to change its base rates and charges. The OUCC is reviewing IPL's request and anticipates filing testimony this spring. Filing and hearing dates will be set in the near future, with updates to be posted on the OUCC's website.

DID YOU KNOW?

Indiana has a winter disconnection moratorium for electric and natural gas utilities, but it only applies under specific circumstances. Whether or not the moratorium applies to a customer, all consumers are responsible for paying bills on time and in full, and letting utilities know if they need to make payment arrangements.



USING A CEILING FAN?
