You are notified on this date that the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") caused the following entry to be made:

On March 29, 2012, the Indiana Office of the Utility Consumer Counselor filed a Notice of Request for Field Hearing ("Notice"). The Notice contained the signatures of forty-five individuals, requesting that a field hearing be held in Evansville, Indiana, to allow public comment on the issues in this Cause. The Commission's rules do not require a Field Hearing in a case of this type, and no Party to the case has formally requested that a Field Hearing be held. The Commission has already scheduled a public Evidentiary Hearing in this Cause, which will be held at 9:30 a.m. EDT on April 19, 2012, in Hearing Room 222, 101 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana. At this hearing, the Parties will present their respective cases, and offer their witnesses for cross-examination.

Starting in October 2011, the Commission began live streaming select hearings in order to increase public access to and transparency of hearings with wide-spread public interest. Because of this, members of the public have the opportunity to observe the regulatory process at work and stay up-to-date on the issues discussed without having to travel to Indianapolis to attend the hearings. The public Evidentiary Hearing in this Cause will be streamed live; thus interested members of the public will have an opportunity to view the hearing and listen to each Party's case. 


