- c) State how these costs were recorded on the books of the entity(s) incurring the costs.
- d) If the costs of this internal time were not "specifically segregated" or tracked, were these costs included in the charges allocated to Indiana-American and other regulated affiliates of American Water?

- b) American Water entities began incurring internal costs in approximately August 2008, continuing through approximately January 2013. Entities that began incurring internal costs at certain times during this period included American Water Works Service Company, Inc., Illinois-American Water Company, Indiana-American Water Company, Inc., Iowa-American Water Company, Missouri-American Water Company, and Pennsylvania-American Water Company.
- c) These costs were not specifically segregated to a special account to track costs relative to the Atrazine issue. Internal time spent on the Atrazine issue was recorded on the books as regular time in the state where it was incurred.

- d) Internal time for Indiana American Water employees would be included in regular time for those employees. Time for Service Company employees specific to Indiana American would either be direct charged to Indiana American or would be coded to an allocation account that would spread the cost over a number of states. As this time was not specifically segregated or tracked, a determination of whether or not Service Company time was direct charged or allocated cannot be made.
