Please be advised that if you desire administrative review of this application denial, you must file a written petition for review at the above address with the Indiana Plumbing Commission stating the reason for the review. As the petitioner, you would have the burden of proving in an administrative hearing that the decision to deny application was incorrect. If you do not file a petition for review, this action will be final.

If you file a petition for review, it must be filed no later than eighteen (18) days from the above stated date unless such date is a Saturday, Sunday, legal holiday under state statute or day that the Professional Licensing Agency's offices are closed during regular business hours in which case, the deadline would be the first day thereafter that is not a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday under state statute or day the Professional Licensing Agency's offices are closed during regular business hours. If you do so, your petition for review will be granted and an administrative law judge of the Indiana Plumbing Commission will conduct an administrative proceeding.



Dear Ms. Sylvia S. Grinstead:

My name is Dan Hrasch. I am writing this letter to gain permission to take the test for my Indiana State Plumbing License. As you will read, I have fulfilled all necessary requirements as stated by the Indiana State Plumbing Licensing Committee. My application, however, has gone through quite a fastidious, albeit understandable, inspection by your Commission, preventing my much desired approval. I am currently employed at Young Plumbing as a service technician, and over the past few years, I have seen my fellow employees, one by one, receive their letters of approval from the IPLA, allowing them to ultimately procure their licenses. My continuing denials have become a theme for comedy amongst my colleagues, as my credentials and applicable experience would seem to be more than enough to gain approval, but nonetheless, I remain, as it were, the last man standing. My only solace is in the possibility that certain aspects of my application must have been overlooked, and I intend to fully justify my qualifications in accordance with all IPLA requirements. I am confident that all previous rejections will be reviewed under these terms, and that I will finally be granted permission to take the test.

In my most recent rejection letter, dated January 25, 2008, the IPLA listed two statutes by which my application was judged, and ultimately denied my application by a rule that is counterintuitive to those very dictates. The Commission denied my application on the sole reason that I failed to provide evidence that I completed four (4) years experience in an approved apprenticeship program. It is no secret that I do not fulfill this requirement. However, the Commission cited Article 860 IC 25-28.5-1-12(c), which clearly states *two* options that can lead to approval - that being the applicant's completion of a four (4) year apprenticeship program, *or* four (4) years of experience in the plumbing trade, as proven by a notarized statement. Furthermore, Article 860 IAC 1-1-9, also cited in my rejection letter, continues to tout the validity of my case, by enumerating in provisions (d) and (e) which detail of both viable options - that being the apprenticeship route and the plumbing experience route. That being said, it is clear that my application was reviewed under the pretenses of my qualifications in regards to apprenticeship route, rather than my qualifications in regards to the plumbing experience route.

I know that the application process is not a comparative procedure, and it is not fair to assume that I would receive acceptance simply because my (seemingly less qualified) co-workers were able to gain approval on their applications. Whereas this is a concern of mine, I am reassured that my argument can be completely justified specifically by its adherence to the codified terms by which my application was submitted. Specifically speaking, if you review my application, you will see that my original submission clearly showed, with W2 form evidence, that I had more than the required four (4) years of plumbing experience. The IPLA then requested a notarized statement (as detailed in 860 IAC 1-1-9), which I supplied. It was the completion of this request that should have resulted in my approval. As you may have guessed, I was disheartened and nonplussed when I received notice that my application was denied under seemingly an entirely new set of rules. Surely it can be seen that my application and all subsequent submissions of W2 forms and notarized letters were aimed at qualifying my four (4) years of plumbing experience. It is my sincere hope that anyone that would have denied my application on the grounds that I have not completed four (4) years of an apprenticeship program must have been missing a significant portion of my file, which trails back more than two years.

All I ask is that you once again review my application under the terms that I have outlined above. I have fully met all requirements as stated in the bylaws of the IPLA, and I have fully complied with all transmissions requested by the IPLA over the years. If a member of the Commission is presented with this information, I see no plausible reason for rejection, including the rationale in my recent (and assumed accidental) denial.

I have the utmost respect for the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency, my local union hall, and my current employer. I have dedicated my life to the trade of plumbing, and have used this passion to provide for my wife and children. All I ask is for a chance – a chance that I have earned. I thank you very much for your consideration, and anxiously await your response.





Comes now, William Ciriello, the Administrative Law Judge designated by the Commission in this proceeding, and hearing having been held, now issues and files his order. Notice is hereby given that any objection to the Administrative Law Judge's Order must be filed with the Commission, identifying the basis of the objection with reasonable particularity, no later than eighteen (18) days from the date of issuance of this order unless such date is a Saturday, a Sunday, a legal holiday under state statute or a day that the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency's offices are closed during regular business hours in which case the deadline would be the first day thereafter that is not a Saturday, a Sunday, a legal holiday under state statute or a day that the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency's offices are closed during regular business hours. This Administrative Law Judge's Order is not the final order of the Commission in this proceeding. However, in the absence of any objection, the Commission either will affirm the Administrative Law Judge's Order as its final order or will serve notice of its intent to review any issue related to the Administrative Law Judge's Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. This proceeding is pending on Samuel L. Montgomery's (hereinafter "Petitioner") petition for review of the Commission's denial of licensure due to failure of the plumbing contractor examination.
2. The petitioner failed to achieve a passing score on the plumbing contractor examination.
3. Petitioner was given notice of the examination failure on September 17, 2007.
4. Petitioner was given notice of the denial of licensure on September 17, 2007.
5. Petitioner filed a timely Petition for Review on September 26, 2007.
6. Petitioner was present at this proceeding without counsel and was given the opportunity to present evidence in this matter.
7. Petitioner did not believe his lead pipe had a cracked hub, but failed to produce evidence contrary to the examiner's determination.
8. Petitioner failed to present sufficient evidence that established Petitioner passed the examination.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. One of the requirements for licensure as a plumbing contractor is the passing of an examination. IC 25-28.5-1-15. In 860 IAC 1-3, the Commission has adopted various rule provisions applicable to examinations. 860 IAC 1-3-1.1 is particularly applicable and reads as follows:

- (a) The plumbing contractor examination shall consist of a practical section, a written section, and a drawing section.
- (b) The practical section of the examination shall include two (2) parts known as the following:
 - (1) The copper pipe project.
 - (2) The soil pipe project.
- (c) The written section of the examination shall be a multiple-choice test.
- (d) The drawing section of the examination shall test the applicant's ability and knowledge concerning sanitary drainage systems and water distribution systems.
- (e) In order to pass the practical section of the examination, an individual must obtain scores of at least seventy percent (70%) on both of the following:
 - (1) The copper pipe project.
 - (2) The soil pipe project.
- (f) An individual must obtain a score of at least seventy percent (70%) on the multiple-choice test in order to pass the written section of the examination.
- (g) An individual must obtain a score of at least seventy percent (70%) on the drawing section in order to pass the drawing section of the examination.

2. Petitioner did not obtain a score of at least 70% on the written examination and therefore, did not fulfill the licensure requirements.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the petitioner's application for licensure as a plumbing contractor is DENIED.

PROPOSED FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, AND ORDER

William J. Ciriello, liaison and member of the Indiana Plumbing Commission, and Joseph Morris (“Respondent”) now submit to the Indiana Plumbing Commission (“the Commission”) their Proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order (“Proposed Settlement”) in the above case.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent’s address on file with the Commission is 6508 south 400 East, Oxford, Indiana 47971. Respondent was a Plumbing Contractor holding license number PC81021029 (expired/non-renewable).
2. In 1999, Respondent installed a water heater for Terry and Janet Hancock (“Hancocks”) on a property located in Benton County, Indiana.
3. On October 18, 2002, a fire erupted at the Hancocks’ property, which caused significant damage to the property.
4. It is believed and averred that the fire referred to in paragraph 3 was caused by Respondent’s failure to properly install the water heater in the Hancocks’ property.

5. On or about November 5, 2003, Hastings Mutual Insurance Company ("Hastings Mutual"), as subrogee of the Hancocks, filed a Complaint in the Benton Circuit Court, Cause Number 04C01-0311-PL-169, alleging that the Respondent was negligent in installing a water heater in the Hancocks' residence. More specifically, Hastings Mutual claimed that Respondent failed to install a stress relief clamp on the top of the water heater where the electrical wires entered the water heater, as required by the National Electric Code.¹

6. On November 12, 2004, after arguments were presented to a jury in Benton Circuit Court, but before a verdict was reached, the Respondent acknowledged liability in the sum of \$95,101.07, and the Benton Circuit Court entered Judgment against Respondent in the amount of \$95,101.07, plus court costs, with 8% interest per year from November 12, 2004.

7. On November 1, 2005, the Benton Circuit Court ordered that Hastings Mutual is entitled to payment from the Plumbers Recovery Fund in the amount of \$20,000, to be made by the Indiana Plumbing Commission.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

8. Respondent's conduct as described above is in violation of Indiana Code 25-1-11-5(a)(4)(A), in that the Respondent continued to practice though he became unfit to practice due to professional incompetence, as evidenced by Respondent installing a water heater in a incompetent manner that resulted in a fire and damage to the Hancocks property.

9. Respondent's conduct as described above required the Indiana Plumbing Commission to pay \$20,000 from the plumbers recovery fund to Hastings Mutual in settlement of a claim and toward the satisfaction of a Judgment entered against Respondent in the Benton Circuit Court on November 12, 2004, for \$95,101.07; therefore, Ind. Code 25-28.5-2-10 requires

¹ The National Electric Code requires that a "stress relief clamp" be installed at those points where the wires pass through the metal holes on the water heater.

that Respondent's license be placed, at least, on suspension until Respondent has repaid the above-mentioned \$20,000 with interest of twelve percent (12%) annum.

MITIGATING CIRCUMSTANCES

10. The Respondent's violations of the Indiana Code are serious violations that normally would warrant a more severe sanction. However, during the settlement conference, the Respondent presented several mitigating factors that he would like the Commission to consider in approving a less severe sanction. The Respondent would like the Commission to take into account the following mitigating factors:

- a. Respondent was at all times cooperative with the Office of the Attorney General;
- b. Respondent has had no other consumer complaints filed against him with the Office of the Attorney General;
- c. Respondent's license to practice plumbing is expired and non-renewable;
and
- d. Respondent has no intention to ever practice plumbing again.

JOINT STIPULATIONS

11. It is expressly understood that this Proposed Settlement is subject to the Commission's acceptance and has no force and effect until a Final Order based upon the Proposed Settlement is issued by the Commission.

12. This Proposed Settlement is executed by Respondent for the purpose of avoiding further administrative action with respect to this cause. Furthermore, should this Proposed Settlement not be accepted by the Commission, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration

of this Proposed Settlement shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commission or any of its members or the Respondent from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.

13. Respondent expressly waives all further procedural steps and expressly waives all rights to seek judicial review of or to otherwise challenge or contest the validity of this Proposed Settlement or the Commission's final order in response.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that:


14. Respondent's license (number PC81021029) to practice plumbing in the State of Indiana is hereby PERMANENTLY REVOKED.





FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER

The Indiana Plumbing Commission (“Commission”) held an administrative hearing on January 23, 2008, in Room W072 of the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency, Indiana Government Center South, 402 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204, concerning a disciplinary complaint filed against the plumbing contractor license of Lewis Marcotte (“Respondent”).

The State of Indiana was represented by Amanda L. Bailor, Deputy Attorney General. The Respondent represented himself at the hearing.

On or about December 26, 2007, the Commission sent Respondent notice of the date, time, and place of the final hearing scheduled for January 23, 2008.

On January 23, 2008, the Commission, after considering the evidence presented and taking official notice of its file in this matter, issues the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order:

Findings of Fact

1. Petitioner is empowered to bring disciplinary complaints in the name of the State of Indiana before the Commission, pursuant to Indiana Code 25-1-7-1 *et seq.*

2. The Commission is charged with the duty and responsibility of regulating the practice of plumbing in the State of Indiana pursuant to Indiana Code 25-28.5-1-3.

3. The Commission is empowered to hold disciplinary hearings pursuant to the authority of Indiana Code 4-21.5 *et seq.*

4. The Respondent is licensed as a plumbing contractor in the State of Indiana under license number PC89100309. Respondent's mailing address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency is 56978 Cedar Road, Osceola, Indiana 46561.

5. On or about May 26, 2005, the City of Mishawaka Plumbing and HVAC Inspector, Robert Michaelis ("Michaelis"), observed two men taking measurements and cutting and installing PVC drain lines at a restaurant project in Mishawaka, Indiana.

6. It is believed and averred that both workers stated to Michaelis that they had neither a plumbing license nor an apprentice registration.

7. It is believed and averred that the workers stated that they were working under L.G. Plumbing's license. Respondent is the owner of L.G. Plumbing, Inc., an unlicensed plumbing corporation.

8. Michaelis issued L.G. Plumbing, Inc. and Respondent a \$25 citation ordinance for violation of IC 25-28.5-1-18.1, which was paid by Respondent on June 30, 2005.

Conclusions of Law

9. The Respondent's conduct as described above is in violation of Indiana Code 25-1-11-5(a)(6), in that, Respondent allowed his name and/or license to be used in connection with an individual who was rendering services beyond the scope of that person's training, experience, and/or competence by allowing two employees without appropriate licensure to take

measurements as well as cut and install PVC drain lines at a restaurant project in Mishawaka, Indiana.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that:

1. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of five hundred dollars (\$500). This penalty must be paid by cash, cashier's check, or money order to the following:


2. Respondent's plumbing contractor license, PC89100309, shall be placed on INDEFINITE PROBATION with no right to petition for withdrawal of probation for six (6) months from the date this final order is issued.
3. Respondent shall submit to the Board monthly reports by the third (3rd) day of each month throughout the term of Respondent's probation. These reports must contain the names and license numbers of all Respondent's employees. The monthly reports shall be submitted in person or by regular mail to:

4. Respondent shall pay the costs of this proceeding as provided under Indiana Code 25-1-11-18. The State of Indiana and Indiana Professional Licensing Agency are hereby ordered to submit all appropriate costs in writing within twenty (20) days from the date of this order. Respondent shall then have forty (40) days from the date of this order to object to any specific amounts claimed. The Board shall then issue an order determining the exact amount of costs to be paid by Respondent.
5. Respondent shall abide by all statutes, rules, and regulations concerning the practice of plumbing in the State of Indiana.
6. Failure of Respondent to abide by the terms of this Final Order shall subject him to the issuance of a Show Cause Order and the possible imposition of further sanctions.



Our law firm is serving as legal counsel for Kenneth V. Jarboe, Jr. with regard to the renewal of his Indiana Master Plumber License.

Kenneth V. Jarboe, Jr. received notice from Rebecca Tinsley, Case Manager, that the Indiana Plumbing Commission ("Commission") denied Mr. Jarboe's application for his Master Plumber License renewal at its January 23, 2008 meeting. Please accept this correspondence as Mr. Jarboe's written petition for review of the January 23, 2008 denial.

Mr. Jarboe operates a small plumbing business (primarily residential work) on Evansville's west side consisting of his son, Andrew J. Jarboe, and his wife, Mildred Frances Jarboe. Andrew J. Jarboe is a licensed journeyman who has worked side by side with his father over the past six years. Mildred Frances Jarboe has been the office manager and assisted with the family business over the past 28 years. She is primarily responsible for all office duties, including receiving mail, accounts receivable, accounts payable, insurance and other similarly related business matters. As you might imagine, the non-renewal of Mr. Jarboe's Master Plumbing License will have a substantial negative impact on this small family operated business.

Mr. Jarboe has held an Indiana Master Plumber License since 1977. No formal consumer complaints have been filed against him with the Better Business Bureau, the Indiana Plumbing Commission, or any other administrative agency during his 30-year career.

In early January 2008, Mr. Jarboe applied for his annual Evansville/Vanderburgh County Building Commission Contractor License or Registration Card ("Evansville Contractor License") at the Evansville/Vanderburgh County Building Commission office. In doing so, Mr.

Jarboe was asked to show proof of his state issued Master Plumber License. It was at this time Mr. Jarboe was made aware that his Master Plumber License had expired. Mr. Jarboe was surprised at the expiration because he had obtained his 2006 and 2007 Evansville Contractor Licenses after his Master Plumber License had expired. The Evansville/Vanderburgh Building Commission will not renew professional licenses such as plumbing without proof of a current state-issued license, which led Mr. Jarboe to reasonably conclude that his Master Plumber License was current and valid.

Furthermore, Mr. and Mrs. Jarboe do not recall receiving any form of notice from the Commission addressing the expiration of the license. The Jarboes have historically relied on these notices and, because of not receiving the notice, did not calendar to renew his license accordingly. Unfortunately for the Jarboes, the mailing of the renewal notice may have arisen during the time the Jarboes were having difficulties in receiving all their mail from the post office. The Jarboes have been made aware of missed correspondence, payments and other important notices that were allegedly sent in the fall and early winter of 2005. Since, through continued discussions with the United States Postal Service, the mailing issue has been resolved to the best of the Jarboes' knowledge.

In light of the 2006 and 2007 renewals of his Evansville Contractor License and the failure to receive the license renewal notice, Mr. Jarboe reasonably believed his Master Plumber License was valid and current. More importantly, once Mr. Jarboe learned that his Master Plumber License had expired, he did not delay in taking immediate action to remedy the situation. More specifically, on January 10, 2008, Mr. Jarboe forwarded the enclosed letter requesting the renewal of his Master Plumber License.

Mr. Jarboe is a responsible man and takes his profession and livelihood seriously. He understands that it is his responsibility to renew his license and pay the applicable renewal fee in a timely fashion. Mr. Jarboe further understands that he has erred in this matter. However, we ask that you take into consideration the extenuating circumstances set forth above including the fact that Mr. Jarboe's request to renew his license is only 10 days past the renewal deadline. It is for these reasons that Mr. Jarboe is requesting the compassion and leniency of the Administrative Review Board in its review of the Commission's denial of his request to renew his Master Plumber License.

Enclosed are sworn affidavits of Mr. and Mrs. Jarboe in support of this Petition. It is the Jarboes' hope that this Petition, along with their sworn testimony, will be sufficient for the Board to fully consider Mr. Jarboe's request for license reinstatement and grant the same immediately.

Since I have always tried to keep my license up to date and did not intentionally allow it to lapse, I hope you will allow me to reinstate my license.



My name is John Kozon and I recently received a call from one of the cities that we do business with, requesting an updated copy of my contractors license. I sent them my Plumbing Corporation License, and they advised me that the contractor's license was separate. I called the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency and they told me my contractor's license was expired and I would have to re-test. This upset me greatly and I do not understand how or why this occurred. I am requesting that I be allowed to renew my contractor's license. I will explain the steps I took and what I received from your office.

In 2005, I became aware in a conversation with Bill Cirrello that if your business was incorporated, you needed a Plumbing Corporation License. I then did two things. I instantly applied for my corporate license, and I attended our next local PHCC meeting and advised all our members of this information. Everyone there was as unaware of this as I was. I read every trade magazine, was a local PHCC President for three years, and spent six years on the state PHCC board. I was never informed that a corporate license was required, by anyone, at any level.

I received my Plumbing Corporate License in 2005 that expired 12/31/2005. Copy of my license is enclosed.

In November 2005 I received paperwork for license renewal for the Plumbing Contractors License. It was renewed instantly and a copy of my license expiring 12/31/07 is also enclosed.

On November 19, 2007, I received paperwork again for my Plumbing Corporation License. We were given a pin number, renewed online, and

promptly received our Plumbing Corporation License expiring 12/31/09. Copy is enclosed.

I would also like your office to check how promptly John Kozon and John Kozon Inc has always renewed their licenses. I have worked in this trade for over thirty years and employed hundreds of people. Our company has done the plumbing and heating work on over 5,000 homes, apartments, hotels, and commercial buildings. Now I am being told I did not renew my license. I could not disagree more. When I had a journeymen's license, I then tested for my contractor's license, passed and received a contractor's license. I did not receive a contractor's and journeymen's license. When I became aware I needed a Plumbing Corporation License, I did so and over two corporate license renewals. I never received anything to renew my contractor's license. I assumed the corporate license was all I needed and was never informed any differently.

When we called your office on 1/14/2008 and they informed me my contractor's license was expired, we informed them that we never received any other paper work other than the Plumbing Corporation License. They said we had. I ask you, why would we renew one license and not the other if we had received it? The answer is simple, because we did not receive it. If you check my renewals over the past 25 years, you will find they were always done promptly, early, and never late.

I am requesting to renew my contractor's license. I have no idea why there are two licenses required, other than the obvious revenue produced for the State of Indiana, but I was never advised of the need for both.



Recently, our office received several inquiries from plumbers in your situation wanting to know how to have a lapsed license renewed or reinstated. Upon receipt of these requests, we were prompted to take a close look at the code cites which govern the reinstatement of delinquent licenses. Based upon this review, it was determined that according to IC 25-1-8-6 (d) you are eligible for the reinstatement of your lapsed plumbing license. IC 25-1-8-6 (d) states in pertinent part: Please submit the information before the boards meeting on March 26, 2008.

(d) Notwithstanding any other law regarding the reinstatement of a delinquent or lapsed license, certificate, or registration, unless a statute specifically does not allow a license, certificate, or registration to be reinstated if it has lapsed for more than three (3) years, the holder of a license, certificate, or registration that was issued by the board that is more than three (3) years delinquent must be reinstated upon meeting the following requirements: The application fee is \$50.00. The renewal fee is \$100.00 and the late fee is \$50.00.

- (1) Submission of the holder's completed renewal application.
- (2) Payment of the current renewal fee established by the board under section 2 of this chapter.
- (3) Payment of a reinstatement fee equal to the current initial application fee.
- (4) If a law requires the holder to complete continuing education as a condition of renewal, the holder shall provide the board with a sworn statement, signed by the holder, that the holder has fulfilled the continuing education requirements required by the board for the current renewal period.
- (5) Complete such remediation and additional training as deemed appropriate by the board given the lapse of time involved.
- (6) Any other requirement that is provided for in statute or rule that is not related to fees.

Therefore, although your license has lapsed for more than three years, upon receipt of the above listed your request for reinstatement will be presented to the board for them to determine the appropriate remediation and additional training needed. Please understand that we will not be able to update your license to active status until you have provided all of the above listed and the board has reviewed that information. If you have any questions or need additional information, please do not hesitate to contact our office.

- *Garbage Disposal
 - Replace unit, using same plumbing
 - Repair electrical parts

- *Water Softener
 - Replace unit
