

Indiana Attorney General's Office: By The Numbers

Amount returned to Hoosiers in 2011 by the AG's Unclaimed Property Division in 2011: **\$48,588,219.38**
Number of Unclaimed Property claims paid in 2011: **75,946**

Indiana telephone numbers currently registered on Indiana's Do Not Call list: approximately **2.1 million**

Number of new criminal appeals cases opened in 2011 where Attorney General represents the State: approximately **1,600**, including state appellate courts and habeas corpus cases in federal district courts.

Administrative complaints filed in 2011 by the Licensing Enforcement and Homeowner Protection Unit: **679**
Motions for Cease & Desist filed in 2011 by LE/HPU– **29**
Civil complaints filed in 2011 by LE/HPU – **40**
Summary Suspensions filed in 2011 by LE/HPU – **44**
Consumer complaints opened in 2011 by LE/HPU – **4,060**
Consumer complaints closed in 2011 (investigations completed) by LE/HPU– **4,610**

Number of cases the AG's Litigation Division opened in 2011: **1,990**

Number of settlements with pharmaceutical companies that the AG's Medicaid Fraud Control Unit has participated in since January 2009 to resolve whistleblower allegations of illegal off-label marketing: **15**.
