### **Indiana Senate honors Probst for service during legislative session**

INDIANAPOLIS –The Indiana State Senate recognized 15 interns last week for their outstanding efforts as Senate Democrat Interns during the 2010 session of the 116<sup>th</sup> Indiana General Assembly. The resolution was authored by members of the Senate Democratic Caucus and was passed unanimously by the Senate.

Among those honored was Anthony Probst, a native of Knightstown, Ind. Probst worked with Indiana State Senators Bob Deig (D-Mount Vernon) and Lindel Hume (D-Princeton). Probst is a graduate of Ball State University where he earned a bachelor's degree in history. Probst also serves in the Indiana National guard as a second lieutenant. His future plans include attending law school with a focus on international law while furthering a military career.

As a legislative intern, Probst worked full time for Sen. Deig and Sen. Hume throughout the session, which convened in January. His duties include constituent correspondence, staffing committee hearings and working closely with senators to research legislative issues. The annual internship program is designed to provide valuable experiences for students who are integrally involved in the legislative process.

The Indiana Senate Democratic Internship is open to all college sophomores, juniors, seniors and graduate students in good academic standing. No specific major is required. Interns work full time for the duration of the session and earn a stipend as well as academic credit. The internship provides students with a unique educational opportunity to gain hands-on experience in Indiana state government.

Applications for the internship are available online in August as well as through the career centers and political science departments of most Indiana colleges.
