Errington urges area students to serve as Senate Pages

INDIANAPOLIS – State Senator Sue Errington, (D-Muncie) today encouraged area students to participate in their state government by serving as a Senate Page during the upcoming session of the Indiana General Assembly.

Students between the ages of 12 and 18 may apply to serve as Senate Pages while the Indiana General Assembly is in session. Students will serve in the State Senate for one day assisting with various legislative activities including running errands within the Statehouse, delivering messages and helping with a variety of other tasks. Being a Senate Page for a day is an excused absence from school.

“This is a great way to get an inside look at the legislative process, and I encourage any student who is interested in government to consider this opportunity,” said Errington.

There are a limited number of page positions available each session and interested students should email or write Sen. Errington in care of the Indiana State Senate, 200 West Washington, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204-2785 and include their full name, address, phone number, age, school, and two different dates they are available. Session begins January 8 and will continue through March 14. Pages serve only on session days, which are generally Monday, Tuesday and Thursdays.
