Dear Ms. Casanova:

Pursuant to IC 4-22-2-28, the Indiana Economic Development Corporation ("IEDC") has reviewed the economic impact analysis for small business associated with rule changes contained in LSA Document 09-87 and proposed by the Indiana Family and Social Services Administration ("FSSA"). The proposed rule amends 405 IAC 5-3-13 for the purpose of including neuropsychological and psychological testing as services that require prior authorization. The proposed rule also amends 405 IAC 5-20-8 for purposes of adding practitioners who may be reimbursed for neuropsychological and psychological testing and includes practitioner obligations.

The economic impact statement prepared by the FSSA indicates that the proposed rule will result in no increased costs to small businesses.
