Criteria 1	Death Claims - Receive \$300K.	\$2,100,000	\$2,100,000
Criteria 2	Physical Injury Claims - Payment based on 65% of submitted medical expenses.	\$2,633,914	\$4,733,914
Criteria 3	Physical Injury Claims with Permanent Paralysis - 37% multiple of submitted medial expenses. No individual to exceed \$600K.	\$182,476	\$4,916,390
Criteria 4	Death Claims - Payment based on multivariate factors (age, education, medical expenses, salary, marital status, and minor children). No individual payment to exceed cap.	\$83,610	\$5,000,000
Criteria 5	Physical Injury Claims - Payment in proportion to Criteria 1 and 2 payments up to full value of submitted medical expenses. Physical Injury Claims with Permanent Paralysis payment in proportion to criteria 1 - 3. No individual payment to exceed cap.		
Criteria 6	Physical Injury Claims - Payment to injured with submitted medical expenses in proportion to payments calculated in criteria 1 -5. No individual payment to exceed cap.		
Criteria 7	Physical Injury Claims - Uniform payment to Physical Injury Claims submitted with no accompanying medical expenses.		
Criteria 8	Non-Physical Injury and Property Damage Claims - Uniform payment to claims submitted.		
Criteria 9	Physical Injury Claims, Non-Physical Injury Claims, and Property Damage Claims - Payment in proportion to payments calculated in criteria 5 and 8 on remainder of funds. No individual payment to exceed cap.		

Note: All individual payments are minimum offers, final amounts will be subject to a pro-rata increase based on the protocol and claimant offer acceptance results.
