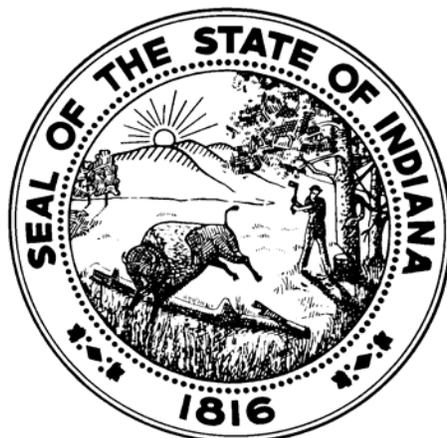

DRUG TESTING RECEIPTS

The City of Gary Drug Court currently offers drug testing to those individuals ordered by the Court to undergo testing, randomly to individuals serving probation, and on an as needed basis to local entities and auxiliary police.

The fee currently being charged by the Drug Court is set at \$10 for auxiliary police and \$15 to local entities. Individuals serving probation or individuals ordered by the judge to undergo testing are not assessed a fee.

Indiana Code 12-23-14.5-3 (a) states: "Except as provided in subsection (b), a drug court established under this chapter and accompanying services are open only to individuals over whom the court that established the drug court has jurisdiction."

Indiana Code 12-23-14.5-16 states: "(a) As a condition of participation in a drug court, a participant may be required to undergo a chemical test or a series of chemical tests as specified by the court. A participant is liable for the costs of all chemical tests required under this section, regardless of whether the costs are paid to the court or the laboratory."
