## **MEMORANDUM**

**Subject: 2016 Summer School Program**

The Department of Education is seeking approval of the 2016 summer school program. Pursuant to 511 IAC Article 12, the courses must be approved by January 15<sup>th</sup> of each year by the State Board of Education. The list of eligible programs is reflected below.

The Department shall reimburse eligible school corporations for approved summer school program classes by taking 1.05 multiplied by the amount expensed for instructional costs of approved programs and reduced proportionately if the appropriation is insufficient to fund all programs at one hundred percent (100%). Instructional costs, for purposes of the program, include only teacher salaries and teacher aide wages.

Eligible programs include the following:

- Grades 1-3 Reading;
- Grades 9-12 Courses toward graduation, including electives;
- Grades 1-8 Language Arts and Mathematics;
- Grades 4-8 Reading;
- Grades 1-8 All other curricular programs, enrichment and multidisciplinary classes; and
- Grades 9-12 Courses not counting toward graduation.
