Indiana State Board of Education Approves Ivy Tech Teacher Prep Program, Technology Loans

INDIANAPOLIS—The Indiana State Board of Education (Board) met virtually today for its August business meeting. Board members approved an extension of the <u>Ivy Tech Career Specialist Permit Pedagogy</u> <u>Component Program</u>. Currently, Ivy Tech Columbus offers the only approved program of this type in Indiana.

Ten applications for school technology advancement loans were approved. The total dollar value to be distributed is \$2,299,666. The school corporations include: Cowan Community School Corporation, Penn-Harris-Madison School Corporation, MSD Warren County, Fort Wayne Community Schools, Porter Township School Corporation, Evansville Vanderburgh School Corporation, Elkhart Community Schools, Milan Community Schools, East Porter County School Corporation, and MSD Warren Township. Board members voted unanimously to elect Pete Miller to serve as secretary of the Board.
