

How the year has been going so far...

- **Emma**
 - Use benchmark data to place students in additional reading and math intervention courses, tiered reading courses and mandatory after school tutoring
 - Use benchmark data to place students in small groups for skill based instruction in ELA, Reading and Science
- NWEA benchmarking expanded to subjects beyond ISTEP+.
 - Math, Reading, Language Usage and Science tested

How the year has been going so far...

- Howe
 - All students placed in two reading and math courses
 - Using benchmark data to provide students targeted tutoring afterschool and during SWAG Saturdays
- NWEA benchmarking expanded to grades and subjects beyond ISTEP+ and ECAs.
 - Grades 7-11 tested (and any 12th graders who have not passed their ECA's)
 - Math, Reading and Science tested

How the year has been going so far...

- **Manual**

- Double blocking students in Algebra enrichment and Algebra I
- Double blocking students in Reading enrichment according to test data

- **Acuity Testing**

- Used to place 9th graders and anyone who hasn't passed the Algebra ECA
- Used to place 10th graders and anyone who hasn't passed the ENG 10 ECA

- **NWEA benchmarking in grades and subjects beyond ECAs.**

- Grades 9-11 tested (and any 12th graders who have not passed ECA's)
- Math, Reading and Science tested
