Student Attendance and Discipline	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The first table measures the student attendance rate, which is currently at 97.11% as of April 8, 2013• The second table tracks the number and type of discipline incidents by grade level. The data shows an overall decreasing trend for all grades, except 6th and 11th graders. The incident percentage for 12th graders remained unchanged at 12%. The “Other” category shows the largest incident numbers, while “Cheating and Stealing” show the lowest numbers.
