(1) Town of Clear Lake, Steuben County Public Question:

“Shall the number of town council members be increased from three to five?”

YES	190	96%
NO	8	4%

(2) Tell City- Troy Township School Corporation, Perry County, Public Question:

Shall the school board members be elected rather than appointed? Actual text of public question follows.

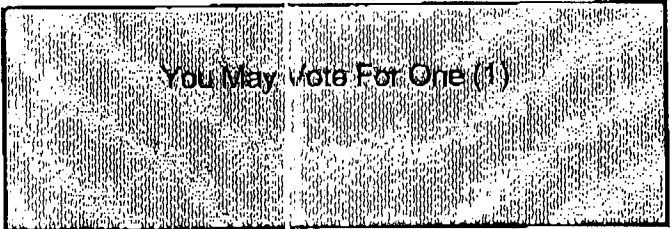
EXISTING PLAN - APPOINTED

5 Members: 3 members residing in Tell City within the city limits and appointed by the City Council of Tell City; and 2 members residing in Troy Township outside the city limits of Tell City (not including Cannelton) and appointed by the Troy Township Trustee and Advisory Board. The existing plan specifies that members: a) must reside in the State of Indiana at least two years; and b) must be a qualified voter within the State of Indiana. Tell City members must have resided within the city for one year prior to being appointed, and Troy Township members must have resided within the township for one year prior to being appointed. Each member serves a four-year term.

SAMPLE

PROPOSED PLAN - ELECTED

5 Members: all 5 members would be elected at staggered times by all registered voters residing in the Tell City-Troy Township School District. Proposed plan specifies that members: a) shall be elected at general election; b) must reside anywhere in the school corporation's district; c) must have been a resident within the school corporation's district for at least one year prior to election date; and d) must be at least 21 years of age and registered to vote. Each member would serve a four-year term. All eligible voters may vote for each school board member.
