



IMPORTANT NOTICE TO VOTERS

After you enter the polling place, state law requires you to **show a photo ID** before signing the poll list and casting a ballot. If you do not have your photo ID with you, you may still enter this polling place and vote by “provisional ballot.”

Your photo ID must meet the following requirements:

1. **Show your name**, which must conform to the name on your voter registration record; (Conform does NOT mean identical)
2. **Show your photograph**;
3. **Include an expiration date** indicating the document has not yet expired (or expired *after* November 6, 2012, the date of the last General Election), except for certain military IDs; and
4. Be issued by the **United States** or the **State of Indiana**.

NOTE: The address on your photo ID does NOT need to match the address on your voter registration record.
