Dear County Election Administrator,

I would like to introduce you to the newly re-structured 16 and 17-year-old poll worker recruitment program now called *Election Day LIVE*. This program allows students to experience democracy first hand, rather than through only government textbooks or television. It encourages our youth to actively participate in our country's democratic process, but also provides your county with additional, tech-savvy poll workers to serve the needs of the voting public.

With your assistance and involvement in *Election Day LIVE*, you will not only help recruit new poll workers, but also include the young people from your community in one of the most important aspects of this country: maintaining free and fair elections.

Student poll workers will be required to meet the general poll worker requirements of the county, including poll worker training, if applicable. A detailed explanation of the requirements is included together with a "starter kit" and program description providing general guidelines and ideas for you to get the program started in your local schools. The program is intended to be easy and hassle-free, while providing you with qualified, reliable, and eager poll workers to help fill vacancies or assist throughout your county.

Your participation in *Election Day LIVE* enables recruitment of new poll workers while, encouraging youth participation in our democracy. Thank you for your commitment to election administration.
