Please accept from the Elkhart County Election Board this amended information about our vote center plan, as it pertains to the 2015 municipal primary and general elections.

The Elkhart County Election Board met on February 27, 2015, to discuss the Vote Center Plan as it pertains to the 2015 municipal primary and general elections.

The board determined it would be best to keep all 27 vote center locations open, but to reduce staffing and voting equipment based on the turnout reports from the 2014 general election. Staffing and equipment are allocated as provided in the below table:

The board also discussed absentee voting for the 28 days prior to Election Day in Elkhart. The board determined it would be best to relocate the Elkhart absentee voting location FROM the County Courts Building to the Lincoln Center, at 608 Oakland Avenue in Elkhart. As the Elkhart location was previously designated as the "satellite" absentee voting location, the board established a resolution regarding the designation, location and hours for all absentee voting locations. Regarding the hours for absentee voting on the two Saturdays prior to Election Day, at four locations, the board determined that the absentee voting hours at all locations should be reduced to 5 hours, with the hours being from 10:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. Said resolution is attached.


