ORDER ADOPTING AMENDED VOTE CENTER PLAN

Comes now JOHN T. MILLION, Chairman, PAULA LANTZ, White County Clerk, and STEVE BIRCH, Member, being all of the members of the White County Election Board, and find, as follows:

1. Pursuant to the requirements of Indiana Code § 3-18-1-18.1-3 and Indiana Code § 3-11-16.1-4, said Board drafted a Voting Center Plan for White County and after due consideration and holding of all required public meetings for comments thereon a final draft of the Voting Center Plan for White County was unanimously approved by the above-named members of the Election Board and said Plan was duly adopted by Order of the Election Board.

2. Pursuant to the requirements of said statutes and of Indiana Code § 3-11-18.1-15, the said Election Board has unanimously amended said Voting Center Plan, and have, by unanimous vote, adopted and approved the amendments to the Plan and have signed the Amended Plan, a copy of which is attached to this Order.

NOW, THEREFORE, the White County Election Board does hereby enter the following Order Adopting said Amended Voting Center Plan as made and amended by the Board:

IT IS ORDERED by the White County Election Board that the White County Voting Center Plan, as amended and unanimously approved by said White County Election Board be, and the same hereby is in all things unanimously approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the Election Board that following the adoption and approval of said Amended Voting Center Plan by the White County Election Board that this Order and said adopted Amended Voting Center Plan be filed with the Election Division of the State of Indiana.

2017 AMENDED White County Vote Center Plan Amended

Whereas, the White County Vote Center Plan was duly adopted on March 8, 2014; and

Whereas, Indiana Code 3-11-18.1-15 authorizes White County to amend a plan adopted with a county election board's order under I.C. 3-11-18.1-3 by unanimous vote of the entire membership of the board approving the plan amendment; and

Whereas, the White County Election Board has determined certain amendments be made to the White County Vote Center Plan in regard to the execution of the Special Election within White County,

Whereas, the White County Election Board so approves the White County plan amendment for vote centers in White County Indiana.


BE IT THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE WHITE COUNTY ELECTION BOARD;

1. The total number of voting centers for this special election will be one (1).
2. The location of the voting center is as follows:
 - a. The Wolcott Park Community Center in Wolcott, Indiana
3. The effective date of the order approving the plan is February 21, 2017.
4. The total number of registered voters affected by the Special Election Princeton Township is 1049 voters.
5. The total number of registered voters affected by the Special Election in Round Grove Township is 203 voters.
6. The total number of registered voters affected by the Special Election in West Point Township is 181 voters.
7. The Voting Center will have one (1) Inspector, one (1) Republican Judge and one (1) Democrat Judge and one (1) Democrat Clerk/Greeter.
8. Every ballot type for each of the three precincts affected by the Special Election shall be available, electronically, at this voting center.
9. Two (2) TSX Voting Machines from Government Business Systems, will be accessible to voters located at:
 - a. The Wolcott Park Community Center
10. Electronic poll books will be supplied by Robis Elections, Inc, will be accessible to voters located at:
 - a. The Wolcott Park Community Center


and will consist of the following items installed at each voting center: Two (2) laptop computers; three (2)st-100 card activators; three symbol barcode scanner; and three(2) Topaz signature pads.

11. Equipment description and accessibility features;
 - a. The laptops will be used by Pollworkers to check voters in. The laptop will store and communicate voter information through a virtual proxy network (VPN). Each laptop will also communicate with the clerk's office central server to upload and download voter information.
 - b. The St-100 card activator will be used to encode the proper ballot style on each voting smart card to be inserted into the TSX touch screen voting machine.
 - c. 2D barcodes located on the back of driver's license or identification cards issued by the State of Indiana will be scanned to identify each voter in the AskED e-pollbook.
 - d. Each voter's electronic signature will be captured from the Topaz signature pad and stored in the AskED e-pollbook.
12. One (1) satellite office is established under IC 3-11-10-26.5, and shall be located in the Wolcott Park Community Center located in Wolcott Indiana in addition to the Clerk's Office of White County to be held in the conference room in the County Building located in Monticello, Indiana on the last two (2) Saturdays prior to the Special Election from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
13. The method and timing of providing voter data to persons entitled to receive it is as follows:
 - a. Data will only be accessible from an administrator's portal using the AskED command center to manage sensitive voter data.
 2. The AskED Command Center will allow the County Clerk to upload and download data from the State Voter Registration Systems.
