
Jasper-Pulaski Fish & Wildlife Area
2023 Dove Hunting Procedures

Season:	Sept. 1–Oct. 15, 2023 Nov. 1–26 and Dec. 16, 2023–Jan. 3, 2024
Limit:	15 per day; 45 possession limit
Shooting hours:	Sept. 1 – 4: noon to 5 p.m. CT (1 p.m. to 6 p.m. ET) Sept. 5 – Oct. 15 and second and third seasons: ½ hour before sunrise to sunset.

Drawing:

The reserved draw will be conducted preseason by computer. Hunters will select their dove field at 11 a.m. CT / noon ET on Sept. 1 and 2 based on the order of choice numbers assigned by the preseason draw.

On Sept. 3 and 4, hunters will be selected by an in-person draw for their choice of location each day at 11 a.m. CT / noon ET. We have a quota of approximately **100** dove hunters.

Standby drawing:

On Sept. 1 and 2, we will have a drawing to fill unclaimed reservations with standby hunters. **Standby hunters must be present and checked in by 11 a.m. CT / noon ET to participate in the drawing.**

All dove fields will be open every day. There will be no field rotations.

- Hunters are required to hunt along specified disced/mowed strips.
- Check field shooting maps and know where the shooting strips are.
- Guns may **not** be carried from the shooting position into the dove field to retrieve birds.
- No dove hunting is allowed outside of the managed dove fields until the field shooting restrictions are lifted Sept. 5.

Nontoxic shot and a game bird habitat stamp are required for dove hunting.

There is a 50-shell limit. The maximum shot size is #6.
