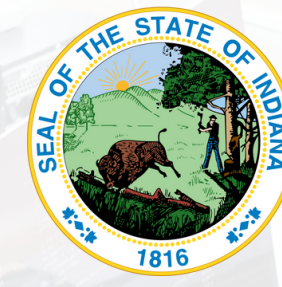


INDICATOR 11 OVERVIEW



Indicator 11: Percentage of children evaluated within 50 instructional days of parental consent (20 days when the student has participated in Response to Intervention (RtI) or when an expedited evaluation is required by discipline procedures identified in 511 Indiana Administrative Code (IAC) 7-44-9.

Indicator 11: Child Find

Purpose of Indicator 11

Establishes state compliance with child find requirements outlined in IDEA.

Ensures that students are evaluated in a timely fashion.

Verifies correction of noncompliance (e.g., delay in provision of services or denial of a free and appropriate public education).

Timeline

After receiving parent/guardian consent: 50 instructional days (standard) or 20 instructional days when the student has participated in RtI or an expedited evaluation is required by discipline procedures identified in 511 IAC 7-44-9).

Timeline Missed: Allowable Reasons

Compliance Codes:

03: Student withdrew from school during the evaluation process.

05: Parent revoked consent for testing.

08: Parent refused to bring student in for evaluation.

Less Than 100%

Continued and Longstanding Noncompliance:

- Root Cause Analysis
- Corrective Action Plan
- Technical assistance (TA) with Indiana IEP's TA Center
- Potential onsite LEA visits
- Subject to virtual audits and other actions

Tips For Success

- Develop evaluation timeline calendar
- Schedule evaluation conference at time of consent
- Develop tracking system to monitor initial evaluation compliance
- Reminders to parents for conference
- If parent reschedules, document in IEP notes that eligibility is "Not yet determined" because they didn't attend to remain compliant.
