Instructions for Creating an Account for the IDOE Moodle Learning Platform

IDOE Moodle Learning Platform – Moodle is an education platform utilized by IDOE to assist school personnel with training tools and resources. Many school professionals (counselors, teachers, school nurses, school safety specialists) have sections specifically designed for their specialty.

The section specific to school nurses includes several online courses and a School Nurse Community.

Online Courses:

Each course has at least one video (some have multiple videos), handouts, a quiz, and a printable certificate once the participant receives a passing quiz score. Each summer the online courses are closed, cleaned, and reopened for participants to take and receive a new certificate with a current date for the upcoming school year. Nine courses have been specifically created for school nurses. There is also an additional course that school nurses can use to train volunteer health aides on the care of students with diabetes.

School Nurse Community:

The School Nurse Community is not a course but is a "file cabinet" filled with school nurse topics. Each topic has a folder that contains links to useful websites as well as guidance documents, articles, references, and toolkits. Topics in the School Nurse Community include advocacy, communicable and chronic diseases, delegation, health laws, medications, reporting, and screenings, just to name a few. It also includes the Indiana School Nurse Manual
