The Children's Museum of Indianapolis encourages all visitors to park in their free parking garage, accessed from the left side of Illinois St. just north of 30th St. Free surface parking is also available in the Water Clock, Train, and Polar Bear Lots, shown in the map below, which can be accessed from Illinois St. north of the parking garage entrance and exit lanes.

They ask visitors to refrain from parking on neighborhood streets.

Both the garage and Water Clock Lot, shown in the map below, have designated ADA parking spaces.
