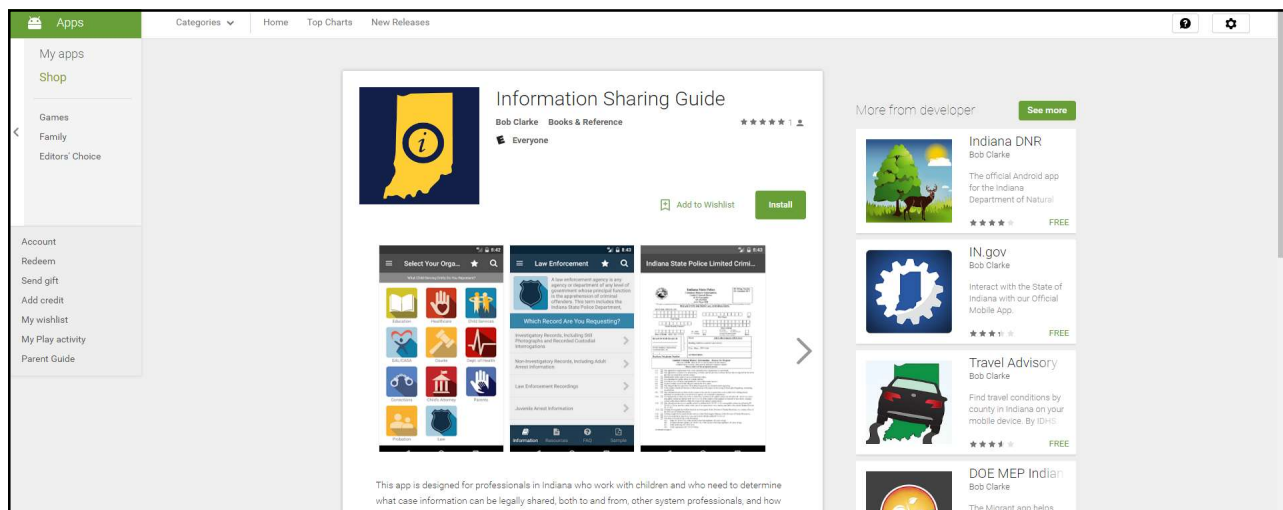

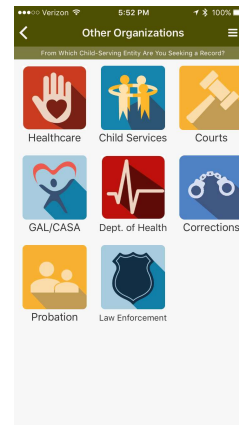
## What to do:

Select which child-serving entity you represent (11 possible tiles); I selected "Education"



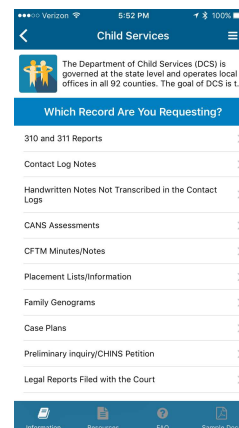
Next:

Then, select which entity from which you want records (10 possible tiles); I selected “Child Services” (DCS)



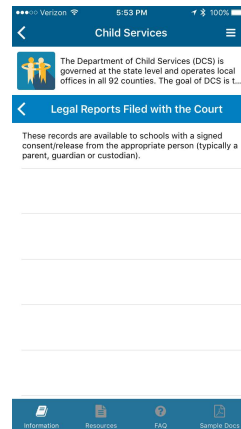
Next . . .

- Allows “sharing”



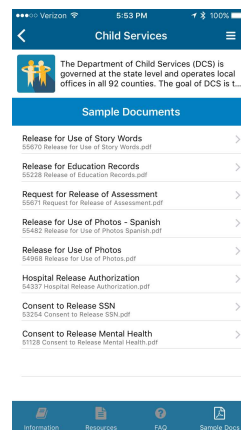

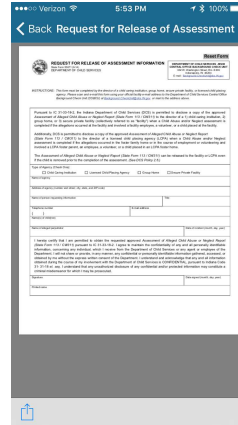

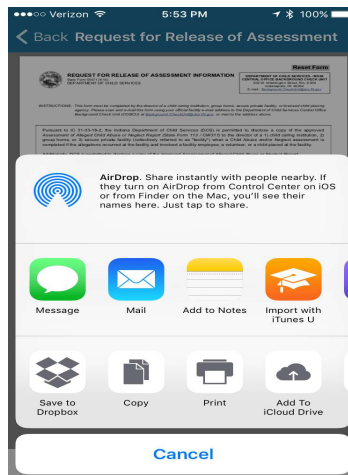

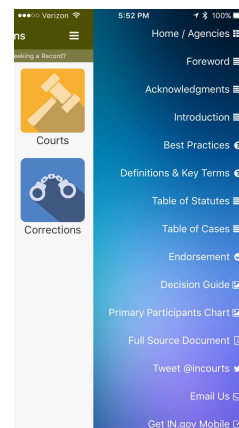


# It works!

- Best practices
- Definitions & key terms
- Table of statutes
- Table of cases

- Decision guide & primary participants
- Full source document (more than 200 pages; legal information, footnoted)
- Email contact
