

## 2023 Conrad Savanna Nature Preserve Deer Reduction Information

Indiana Department of Natural Resources will host deer reduction hunts at Conrad Savanna Nature Preserve in 2023. Hunters wishing to hunt the property must sign in at LaSalle Fish & Wildlife Area and take a hunter permit card. Cards should be returned to one of the drop boxes in the parking lots at Conrad Savanna Nature Preserve. See the map below for more information.

## **Hunt Dates:**

Firearms Season: Nov. 18–Dec. 3 Muzzleloader Season: Dec. 9–24

Archery Season: Nov. 18, 2023-Jan. 7, 2024

## **Rules:**

No hunting will be allowed between Beaver Lake Ditch and U.S. 41. All property and equipment rules must be followed. View the <u>Indiana Hunting & Trapping Guide</u> for more details on regulations. No bonus antlerless permits allowed. Deer stands may be placed on the property from Nov. 1, 2023–Jan. 10, 2024. All other DNR regulations regarding stands apply.

Hunters must park in one of the three designated parking areas at Conrad Savanna Nature Preserve. Parking is limited and can handle about 12 vehicles. See the map below for parking locations.

Successful hunters must report harvest information on their permit card and place it into one of the drop boxes in the parking lots at Conrad Savanna Nature Preserve. See the map for drop box locations in each of the three parking lots.
