

ROUND LAKE WETLAND CONSERVATION AREA



Round Lake Wetland Conservation Area

(Managed By Kankakee Fish & Wildlife Area)

- **Description:** Round Lake WCA is approximately 188 acres. It contains the 31 acre Round Lake and surrounding wetland habitat. Approximately 50 acres of the property consists of upland habitat.
- **Location:** Round Lake WCA is located on County Road 150 East between County Roads 400 South and 500 South in Starke County.
- **Parking:** Parking is located in a designated lot off of County Road 150 East. All other property lanes or roads are closed to vehicles.
- **Hunting Regulations:** All hunting is allowed on the property within State and Federal Regulations. No check-in is required for hunting.
- **Fishing Regulations:** All fishing is subject to State regulations. No check-in is required for fishing. Electric trolling motors only.
- Other Permitted Uses: Hiking, mushroom hunting, and wildlife viewing are also allowed. No check-in is required.
- **Restricted Uses:** No open fires. No camping. No Swimming. No horseback riding. No ATV's or snowmobiles.

Trapping is allocated through a drawing held at Kankakee FWA.
