

SPRIG SLOUGH WETLAND CONSERVATION AREA



Sprig Slough Wetland Conservation Area

(Managed By Kankakee Fish & Wildlife Area)

- **Description:** Sprig Slough WCA is approximately 109 acres. This property contains one shallow water impoundment while the rest of the property is composed of warm season grasses.
- **Location:** Sprig Slough WCA is located at the intersection of County Roads 500 West and 2100 South in LaPorte County.
- **Parking:** Parking is located in a designated lot off of County Road 2100S South. All other property lanes or roads are closed to vehicles.
- <u>Hunting Regulations</u>: Waterfowl Hunting by draw, only on Tuesdays and Saturdays. Drawing held at Kankakee FWA. All other hunting allowed after noon during waterfowl season.

Check-in required.

Steel shot only on this property.

All other hunting allowed within State and Federal Regulations.

- <u>Other Permitted Uses</u>: Hiking, mushroom hunting, and wildlife viewing are also allowed. No check-in is required.
- **Restricted Uses:** No open fires. No camping. No Swimming. No horseback riding. No ATV's or snowmobiles.

Trapping is allocated through a drawing held at Kankakee FWA.
