### **CMS Memo QSO-23-18-NH: Posting of Nursing Home Ownership/Operatorship Affiliation Data on Nursing Home Care Compare Website**

Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) released [QSO-23-18-NH](#) on June 28. The memo indicates CMS will include ownership and operatorship affiliation information on the [Nursing Home Care Compare website](#). CMS will also publish combined inspection, staffing, quality, and other performance metrics across groups of nursing homes with shared ownership and operatorship on [data.cms.gov](https://data.cms.gov).
