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## **Emergency Order Granting Temporary Blanket Waivers**

### **Comprehensive Care Facilities**

Pursuant to the “Declaration of Public Health Emergency for Coronavirus Disease 2019 Outbreak” issued by Governor Eric Holcomb on March 6, 2020 and IC4-21.5-4-1, and as authorized by IC 16-28-1-10 and the September 18, 1991 resolution of the Executive Board of the Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH), the Indiana Health Commissioner hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. Living Arrangements
2. Transfer and Discharge Rights
3. Personnel
4. Personnel
5. Physician Services
6. Activities
7. Dining Assistant

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## **Emergency Order Authorizing Temporary Personal Care Attendant Position and Training for Nursing Homes**

Pursuant to the “Declaration of Public Health Emergency for Coronavirus Disease 2019 Outbreak” issued by Governor Eric Holcomb on March 6, 2020 (the “Governor’s Declaration”) and IC4-21.5-4-1 the Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH), the Indiana Health Commissioner hereby ORDERS as follows effective retroactively as of March 6, 2020:

- Licensed Indiana comprehensive care facilities, as a supplement to personnel may train and subsequently utilize temporary Personal Care Aides (PCA).
