

3. Respondent may now reside at 2006 Landing Drive, Apartment 4, Louisville, Kentucky 40218.
4. The Board has jurisdiction to summarily suspend Respondent's license in accordance with Indiana Code ch. 4-21.5-4 and Indiana Code § 25-1-9-10.
5. Respondent legally changed her name from Jarena Lanet Fowler to Rena La Net Baumia on August 5, 2013.
6. On December 21, 2015, Respondent again legally changed her name from Rena La Net Baumia to Rena DaNet Baumia.
7. Respondent holds a Kentucky LPN license under number 2035711 under the name Jarena Lanet Fowler.
8. Respondent's Kentucky license was placed on probation on August 24, 2016 based on her having been convicted of the following in Kentucky:
 - a. Theft of Identity of Another Without Consent in October 2012;
 - b. Assault in the 3rd Degree (on Police/Parole Officer) in October 2012;
 - c. Fleeing or Evading Police in the 2nd Degree (on foot) in October 2012;
 - d. Giving a Peace Officer a False Name or Address in October 2012;
 - e. Theft of Identity of Another Without Consent in October 2012;
 - f. 4 Counts of Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument in December 2012;
 - g. 2 Counts of False Statement/ID/Financial Condition to Get Credit in December 2012;
 - h. 4 Counts of Theft by Deception – Including Cold Checks Under \$10,000 in December 2012
 - i. Theft by Deception 00 Including Cold Checks under \$500 in January 2011;
 - j. 2 Counts of Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument, 2nd Degree in November 2010;
 - k. Theft by Unlawful Taking, Auto \$10,000 or More in November 2010;
 - l. 2 Counts of Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument, 2nd Degree in October 2010;
 - m. 2 Counts of Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument, 2nd Degree in October 2010;
 - n. 3 Counts of Theft by Deception – Including Cold Checks under \$10,000 in October 2010
 - o. Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument, 2nd Degree in October 2010;
 - p. Theft by Deception – Including Cold Checks under \$500 in September 2010;

- q. Attempted Theft by Failure to Make Required Disposition of Property in March 2010;
 - r. Attempted Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument, 2nd Degree in December 2009;
 - s. Theft by Deception – Including Cold Checks under \$300 in November 2009;
 - t. Theft by Deception – Including Cold Checks under \$500 in November 2009;
 - u. Theft by Deception – Including Cold Checks under \$300 in November 2009;
 - v. Attempted Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument, 2nd Degree in December 2009;
 - w. Theft by Deception – Including Cold Checks under \$300 in March 2009;
 - x. OBS Theft by Deception – Including Cold Checks under \$300 in January 2006.
9. Respondent was released from the Kentucky Department of Corrections in February of 2016 after serving five (5) years in prison, and she is currently on parole in Kentucky.
10. On March 7, 2017, Respondent was terminated from Green Valley Care Center (“Green Valley”) in New Albany, Indiana for “fraudulent behavior resulting in theft of company time.”
11. Respondent has never advised the Board of any of the aforementioned convictions.
12. While employed at Green Valley, Respondent reported working and was paid for 210 hours that she did not actually work. Respondent was ultimately caught on Green Valley security cameras clocking in at the facility, leaving the premises, and then returning approximately twelve hours later to clock out.
13. Based on the facts stated above, Respondent presents a clear and immediate danger to the public’s health and safety if allowed to continue to practice nursing in Indiana.

WHEREFORE, RESPONDENT IS ORDERED to immediately cease and desist all acts constituting the practice of Nursing for a period of ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order.
