**NOTICE OF PROPOSED DEFAULT**

A disciplinary hearing was scheduled to be held on September 15, 2005, before the Indiana State Board of Nursing ("Board") in the Auditorium of the Conference Center in the Indiana State Government Center South, 402 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana, 46204, to consider the Administrative Complaint filed by the State of Indiana ("Petitioner") on January 24, 2005, against Deborah Kay Snyder, R.N. ("Respondent").

The State of Indiana was represented by Steven P. Douglas, Deputy Attorney General. The Respondent failed to appear in person or by counsel although she did contact the Board, informing them that she had received notice at her Colorado address and would not be present at the hearing.

The Board, after taking official notice of its file in the matter pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-24, by a vote of 5 in favor, 0 against, and 0 abstaining, issues a Notice of Proposed Default on the following grounds:

1. Respondent's address on file with the Board is 4457 North 300 East,

Anderson, Indiana, 46012. Respondent has recently moved to Colorado. Her Colorado address is 40700 Highway 160, Mancos, Colorado, 81328, and she is a duly licensed Registered Nurse in the State of Indiana having been issued license number 28097414A.

2. An Administrative Complaint was filed by the Petitioner against the Respondent in this matter on or about January 24, 2005.

3. On August 18, 2005, this matter was continued by the Board so that notice could be sent to the Respondent at her new Colorado address. The Respondent received the notice and contacted the Board. The notice informed the Respondent of the date, time and place of the disciplinary hearing scheduled for September 15, 2005. The Respondent contacted the Board through Board Director, Tonja Thompson, verifying that she had received the notice of hearing set for September 15, 2005.

4. Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-20, Respondent was provided adequate notice of the disciplinary hearing and failed to appear for the scheduled hearing on September 15, 2005 or ask for a continuance.

### **ORDER**


For the Respondent's failure to appear for the scheduled hearing, the Board issued the following **Notice of Proposed Default**:

In accordance with Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-24, the Respondent must file a written motion within seven (7) days of service of this Order requesting the Board not enter a default order in this case and stating the reasons relied upon for that request. Failure of the Respondent to file such a written motion within seven (7) days shall result in the issuance of a default order. If the Respondent timely files a motion, the Board shall consider said motion along with any relevant facts in determining whether a default order

should be entered. Should a default order be entered against the Respondent, the Board may hold further proceedings it deems appropriate to complete this case without the participation of the Respondent.
