**PETITION FOR INVOLUNTARY ORDER REFERRING LICENSEE INTO
THE INDIANA STATE NURSES ASSISTANCE PROGRAM**

The State of Indiana (Petitioner), by Deputy Attorney General Jason J. Gross, petitions the Indiana State Board of Nursing (Board) to Involuntarily Order Andrea Webb, L.P.N. (licensee), to be referred to the Indiana State Nurses Assistance Program (ISNAP), and in support of its Petition states the following:

1. Licensee is a Licensed Practical Nurse in the State of Indiana, having been issued license number 27064879A on March 31, 2010 by the Board.
2. Licensee's address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency (IPLA) is 111 Newport Court, Mishawaka, Indiana 46544.
3. This Board has jurisdiction to involuntarily refer Licensee to ISNAP pursuant to an Order in accordance with the provisions of 848 IAC 7-1-5(c)(2).
4. On August 17, 2015, Respondent submitted to a pre-employment drug screen pursuant to her application for an L.P.N. position at Golden Living.
5. On August 24, 2015, the results of Respondent's August 17, 2015 drug screen were reported. Respondent tested positive for marijuana.
6. On September 1, 2015, Rhonda J. Wigg, Drug Testing Coordinator at Golden Living, submitted a consumer complaint to Petitioner alleging that Respondent tested positive for marijuana on her pre-employment drug screen.
7. On December 14, 2015, Petitioner mailed a letter to Respondent demanding her attendance at an Informal ISNAP conference.

8. On December 20, 2015, Petitioner's letter demanding Respondent's attendance at the Informal ISNAP conference was returned to Petitioner with a notice that the letter was undeliverable and that no forwarding address was available.


Due to the above facts, Licensee's alleged conduct is indicative of impairment from alcohol or other drugs and involuntary referral to ISNAP for evaluation is appropriate to determine eligibility for rehabilitation and monitoring.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner requests that the Board involuntarily refer Licensee to ISNAP pursuant to an Order and for all other proper relief.
