ORDER WITHDRAWING PROBATION

A hearing having been held on December 6, 2012, on a petition for withdrawal of probation, the Medical Licensing Board of Indiana, by a vote of 7-0-0, now issues its Order Withdrawing Probation as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. This matter is before the Board on Becky Leigh Allmon's ("Respondent") petition for withdrawal of her probation. In its Corrected Findings of Fact, Ultimate Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law and Order issued on April 1, 2011, the Board placed the Respondent on indefinite probation. Various terms and conditions were imposed.

2. The Respondent has established that the deficiency that required disciplinary action has been remedied.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Ind. Code § 25-1-9-9(b) states in pertinent part that:

The board may withdraw or modify [a] probation [imposed in a disciplinary proceeding] if it finds, after a hearing, that the deficiency that required disciplinary action has been remedied, or that changed circumstances warrant a modification of the order.

2. Because the Respondent has established that the deficiency that required disciplinary action has been remedied, she qualifies for withdrawal of her probation.


ORDER
