**ORDER EXTENDING SUMMARY SUSPENSION**

The Medical Licensing Board of Indiana ("Board"), pursuant to the authority of Indiana Code § 4-21.5-4-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 25-1-9-10, at the April 24, 2003 regularly scheduled meeting at the Indiana Government Center South, 302 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46024, by a vote of 6-0-0, **SUMMARILY SUSPENDS** the medical license held by Walter O. Anderson, M.D. ("Respondent") for 90 days, as the Board finds that an emergency exists and that the Respondent represents a clear and immediate danger to the public health and safety if allowed to practice medicine in the State of Indiana.

The State of Indiana was represented by Shelley M. Johnson, Deputy Attorney General. The Respondent did not appear in person and was not represented by counsel.

This **NON-FINAL** emergency order is based upon evidence in the Board's file.

In the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Mississippi, Respondent has been charged with nine (9) Counts of Health Care Fraud, two (2) Counts of False Statements Relating to Health Care Matters, six (6) Counts of Laundering of Monetary

Instruments, and one (1) Count of Criminal Forfeiture. On May 2, 2002, by a vote of 7-0-0, the Board summarily suspended Respondent's license based on the above listed charges. Respondent's original summary suspension expires on August 13, 2002. On or about September 20, 2002, Respondent pled guilty to one count of money laundering in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1957. Respondent was sentenced to thirty months of imprisonment. Upon Respondent's release from imprisonment, Respondent is subject to supervised release for a period of three (3) years. Respondent was assessed fines in the amount of \$6,100.00, balance due no later than ninety (90) days.

Based upon the above evidence, the Board finds that Respondent represents a clear and immediate danger to the public health and safety if allowed to continue to practice medicine.

**WHEREFORE, RESPONDENT IS ORDERED** to immediately cease all acts constituting the practice of medicine for an additional period of 90 days from the date of this Order.
