**NOTICE OF PROPOSED DEFAULT ORDER**

A final hearing was scheduled to be held on May 23, 2019, in Room W064 of the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency, Indiana Government Center South, 402 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204, concerning the Administrative Complaint filed by the State against the license of Kendal T. Freeman, M.D., (“Respondent”).

The State of Indiana was represented by Tina L. Mann, Deputy Attorney General. Respondent failed to appear in person or by counsel.

Pursuant to Indiana Code § 4-21.5-3-24, the Medical Licensing Board of Indiana (“Board”) issues this Notice of Proposed Default Order on the following grounds:

1. Respondent’s address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency (“IPLA”) is 4971 Shoreview Drive, Coloma, MI 49038.
2. On March 26, 2019, IPLA sent a notice to Respondent at his listed address informing Respondent of the date, time and place of the final hearing.
3. On May 23, 2019, Respondent failed to appear in person or by counsel for the final hearing.
4. Pursuant to Indiana Code § 4-21.5-3-20, Respondent was provided adequate notice of the final hearing and failed to appear for said conference.

**ORDER**

For Respondent's failure to appear for the scheduled final hearing, the Board issues the following Notice of Proposed Default Order:

In accordance with Indiana Code §4-21.5-3-24, Respondent must file a written motion within seven (7) days of service of this Order requesting the Board not enter a default order in this case and stating the reasons relied upon for that request. Failure of the Respondent to file such a written motion within seven (7) days shall result in the issuance of a default order. If Respondent timely files a motion, the Board shall consider said motion along with any relevant facts in determining whether a default order should be entered. Should a default order be entered against Respondent, the Board may hold further proceedings it deems appropriate to complete this case without the participation of Respondent.
