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COMPLAINT

This complaint is brought against the pharmacist license of Shannon Renee Adams, R.Ph. (Respondent), by the Office of the Attorney General, by counsel, Deputy Attorney General Darren R. Covington, on behalf of the State of Indiana (Petitioner) and pursuant to Ind. Code § 25-1-7-7, Ind. Code § 25-1-5-3, Ind. Code ch. 25-26-13, the Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Ind. Code art. 4-21.5 and Ind. Code ch. 25-1-9 and in support alleges and states:

FACTS

1. Respondent's address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency is 11131 Harrington Lane, Fishers, Indiana, 46038.
2. Respondent is a licensed pharmacist in the State of Indiana having been issued license number 26019548A on August 3, 1998.
3. On or around March 19, 2013, the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) completed a routine inspection at Pharmacorr, LLC.
4. At the time of DEA's inspection, Respondent was working as a pharmacist for Pharmacorr, LLC.
5. During the DEA inspection, Respondent was identified as having an unreported criminal history.

6. On or around May 6, 2005, Respondent was charged with Criminal Mischief, a Class A Misdemeanor, in Vigo County, Indiana Superior Court, under Cause Number 84D04-0505-CM-01189.

7. According to the Terre Haute Police Department report, Respondent's roommate reported that when she came home from work the inside of the house was torn apart and Respondent was in an intoxicated state. Respondent told police that she had taken fifteen Valium pills and her hands had been cut. Respondent told the emergency room physician that she attempted to commit suicide, and that she had obtained the Valium from work.

8. Respondent pled guilty on or around June 2, 2005 and was placed on informal probation for one year.

9. On or around May 9, 2006, Respondent completed her license renewal answering no to, "Since you last renewed, have you been convicted of or pled guilty to a violation of a federal or state law or are criminal charges pending?"

COUNT I

10. Paragraphs 1 through 9 are incorporated by reference herein.

11. Respondent violated Ind. Code § 25-1-9-4(a)(1)(A) in that Respondent engaged in fraud or material deception in order to obtain a license to practice as evidenced by Respondent not reporting on her license renewal pleading guilty to Criminal Mischief in 2005.

COUNT II

12. Paragraphs 1 through 9 are incorporated by reference herein.

13. Respondent violated Ind. Code § 25-1-9-4(a)(2)(B) in that the Respondent has been convicted of a crime that is harmful to the public as evidenced by Respondent pleading guilty to Criminal Mischief in 2005.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner demands an order against the Respondent that:

1. Imposes the appropriate disciplinary sanction;
2. Directs Respondent to immediately pay all costs incurred in the prosecution of this case; and,
3. Provides any further relief as the Board deems just and proper.
