AMENDED PETITION FOR SUMMARY SUSPENSION

The State of Indiana, Office of the Indiana Attorney General, herein (“Petitioner”), by counsel, Deputy Attorney General, Sha’na Terry, pursuant to Ind. Code Ch. 4-21.5-4 *et seq.*, and Ind. Code Sec. 25-1-9-10, submits to the Indiana Board of Pharmacy (“Board”), Petitioner’s “Petition for Summary Suspension” (“Petition”), against the pharmacist license of Jared Bachman (“Respondent”). In support of its Petition, Petitioner alleges the following:

1. Respondent is a pharmacist in the State of Indiana having been issued license number 26021573A on September 10, 2004.
2. Respondent’s address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency (“IPLA”) is 3944 Jonathan Ridge, Columbus, Indiana 47201.
3. Respondent is a “practitioner” as that term is defined by Ind. Code Sec. 25-1-9-2.

FACTS SUPPORTING CLEAR AND IMMEDIATE DANGER

4. At all relevant times, Respondent was employed as a pharmacist at CVS that floats to multiple locations in Indiana.
5. On or about August 7, 2023, Respondent admitted to diverting approximately 200 Zolpidem, 10-15 tablets of oxycodone, and 4-5 tablets of suboxone for personal use from multiple stores over the past two months.

6. On or about August 7, 2023, Respondent was terminated from his position as a pharmacist at CVS.

7. On or about August 7, 2023, Respondent was charged in Batholomew County, Indiana for Leaving the Scene of an Accident, a Class B Misdemeanor under cause number 03D02-2308-CM-004101. At the time of this arrest, the officer located drugs on his person believed to be Zolpidem (Ambien).


8. On or about August 10, 2023, Respondent was charged in Brown County, Indiana for Theft, a Level 6 Felony under cause number 07C01-2308-F6-000268. This theft is for the drugs taken during his employment at CVS.

CHARGE – CLEAR AND IMMEDIATE DANGER TO THE PUBLIC

1. Pursuant to Ind. Code 25-1-9-10, Respondent represents a clear and immediate danger if allowed to continue to practice.

WHEREFORE, pursuant to Ind. Code 4-21.5-4, Petitioner requests that this Board set this matter for an emergency hearing on Petitioner’s Petition, grant Petitioner’s Petition, and suspend Respondent’s Indiana pharmacist license for a period of not more than ninety (90) days, and any other relief provided for by law.

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
