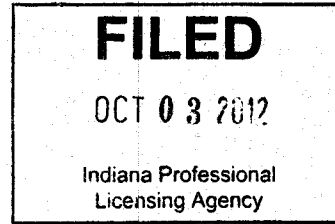

SUMMARY SUSPENSION ORDER

An administrative hearing was held on October 1, 2012, before the Indiana Board of Pharmacy ("Board") in Room W064 of the Indiana Government Center South, 402 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204, to consider the Petition for Summary Suspension ("Petition") filed against Danyel Maree Franklin, C.Ph.T. ("Respondent") by the State of Indiana ("Petitioner") on September 25, 2012.

The State of Indiana was represented by Darren R. Covington, Deputy Attorney General. Respondent appeared in person and waived her right to counsel.

The Board, pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-4-1 *et seq.* and Ind. Code § 25-1-9-10, by a vote of 5-0-0, **SUMMARILY SUSPENDS** the certification held by Respondent for ninety (90) days as the Board finds that an emergency exists and that Respondent represents a clear and immediate danger to the public health and safety if allowed to practice pharmacy in the State of Indiana.

This **NON-FINAL** emergency order is based on evidence supporting the following findings:

1. This Board has jurisdiction to suspend Respondent's license in accordance with the provisions of Ind. Code ch. 4-21.5-4 and Ind. Code § 25-1-9-10.

2. Respondent's address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency is 4510 Candletree Circle, Apartment 14, Indianapolis, Indiana 46254.

3. Respondent is a licensed pharmacy technician in the State of Indiana having been issued certification number 67016073A on July 20, 2009.

4. On or around May 1, 2012, Respondent was charged in Marion County, Indiana Superior Court with Conspiracy to Commit Dealing in Cocaine, a Class B Felony, Dealing in Cocaine, a Class B Felony, and Possession of Cocaine, a Class D Felony, under Cause Number 49G20-1204-FB-025407.

5. According to the Probable Cause Affidavit, on or around September 28, 2011, an Undercover Detective and a Confidential Informant purchased crack cocaine from a black male known as "G," later identified as Sidney Galloway.


6. According to the Probable Cause Affidavit, Respondent drove "G" to the location of the buy. Respondent remained in the car while the buy took place. Respondent witnessed the buy take place. Respondent told the Undercover Detective that she could call "G" anytime and asked where the Undercover Detective would like to meet "G" the next time. Respondent drove "G" away after the buy was completed.

WHEREFORE, RESPONDENT IS ORDERED to immediately cease all acts constituting the practice of pharmacy for a period of ninety (90) days, effective October 1, 2012.
