SUMMARY SUSPENSION ORDER

An administrative hearing was held on December 10, 2012 before the Indiana Board of Pharmacy ("Board") in Room W064 of the Indiana Government Center South, 402 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204, to consider the Petition for Summary Suspension ("Petition") filed against Jessica Dalley, C.Ph.T. ("Respondent") by the State of Indiana ("Petitioner") on December 4, 2012.

The State of Indiana was represented by Darren R. Covington, Deputy Attorney General. Respondent failed to appear in person or by counsel.

The Board, pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-4-1 *et seq.* and Ind. Code § 25-1-9-10, by a vote of 6-0-0, **SUMMARILY SUSPENDS** the certification held by Respondent for ninety (90) days as the Board finds that an emergency exists and that Respondent represents a clear and immediate danger to the public health and safety if allowed to practice pharmacy in the State of Indiana.

This **NON-FINAL** emergency order is based on evidence supporting the following findings:

1. This Board has jurisdiction to suspend Respondent's certification in accordance with the provisions of Ind. Code ch. 4-21.5-4 and Ind. Code § 25-1-9-10.

2. Respondent's address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency is 220 S. Martin Avenue, Muncie, Indiana 47303. Respondent's last known address is 612 W. Adams Street, Alexandria, Indiana 46001.

3. Respondent is a licensed pharmacy technician in the State of Indiana having been issued certification number 67021200A on June 25, 2012.

4. At all times relevant herein, Respondent worked as a pharmacy technician at Meijer Pharmacy in Muncie, Indiana.

5. On or around October 31, 2012, Respondent's employment was terminated from Meijer Pharmacy for diverting hydrocodone.

6. On or around November 2, 2012, Respondent was charged in Delaware County, Indiana Circuit Court with one count of Theft, a Class D Felony and, one count of Possession of a Controlled Substance, a Class D Felony, under Cause Number 18C03-1211-FD-0234.

WHEREFORE, RESPONDENT IS ORDERED to immediately cease all acts constituting the practice of pharmacy for a period of ninety (90) days, effective December 10, 2012.

ORDERED, this 14 day of December, 2012; this Summary Suspension Order is effective as of December 10, 2012.
