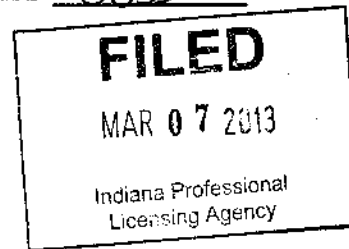

PETITION FOR SUMMARY SUSPENSION

The State of Indiana ("Petitioner"), by Counsel, Office of the Indiana Attorney General, by Deputy Attorney General Darren R. Covington, moves the Indiana Board of Pharmacy ("Board") to summarily suspend the pharmacy technician license of Arielle L. Freeman, C.Ph.T. ("Respondent") for ninety (90) days and in support of its petition states the following:

1. This Board has jurisdiction to suspend Respondent's license in accordance with the provisions of Ind. Code ch. 4-21.5-4 and Ind. Code § 25-1-9-10.
2. Respondent's address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency is P.O. Box 2021, West Lafayette, Indiana 47996.
3. Respondent is a licensed pharmacy technician in the State of Indiana having been issued license number 67021019A on May 23, 2012.
4. At all times relevant herein, Respondent was employed as a pharmacy technician with Target Stores ("Target") in Lafayette, Indiana.
5. On or around January 24, 2013, Respondent admitted to diverting controlled substances for personal use in a written statement given to Target.
6. In her written statement, Respondent admitted to diverting as much as 180 prescription drug tablets per week.

7. On or around February 14, 2013, Target submitted a DEA Form 106 Report of Theft or Loss of Controlled Substances, which reported 1,227 missing clonazepam tablets, 10,664 missing hydrocodone tablets, and 5,614 missing alprazolam tablets.

8. Due to the above facts, Respondent represents a clear and immediate danger to the public health and safety if allowed to continue to practice as a pharmacy technician in Indiana.

WHEREFORE, the State of Indiana requests that this Board set a hearing on this Petition for Summary Suspension and suspend Respondent's license for a period of ninety (90) days and for all other proper relief.
