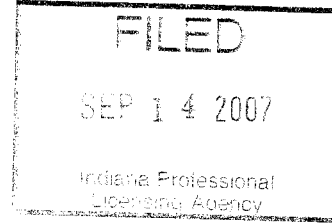

NOTICE OF PROPOSED DEFAULT ORDER

The Indiana Board of Pharmacy ("Board") scheduled a hearing on the State's Complaint on September 10, 2007.

The State of Indiana was represented by Heather Kennedy, Deputy Attorney General. The Respondent was not present in person or by counsel.

The Board, after taking official notice of its file in the matter and pursuant to Indiana Code 4-21.5-3-24, by a vote 7-0-0, issues a Notice of Proposed Default Order on the following grounds:

1. Respondent's address on file with the Board is 307 E. Bennett St., Westport, IN 47281 and she is a certified pharmacy technician in the State of Indiana holding license number 67000170A.
2. An Administrative Complaint was filed by the State of Indiana against the Respondent in this matter on or about August 6, 2007.
3. On August 28, 2007, the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency sent a notice to Respondent at her last reported address, informing Respondent of the date, time and place of the disciplinary hearing.

4. Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-20, Respondent was provided adequate notice of the disciplinary hearing and failed to appear for the scheduled hearing.

ORDER

For the Respondent's failure to appear for the scheduled hearing, the Board issues the following Notice of Proposed Default:

In accordance with Indiana Code § 4-21.5-3-24, the Respondent must file a written motion within seven (7) days of service of this Order requesting that the Board not enter a default order in this case and stating the reasons relied upon for that request. Failure of the Respondent to file such a written motion within seven (7) days shall result in the issuance of a default order. If the Respondent timely files a motion, the Board shall consider said motion along with any relevant facts in determining whether a default order should be entered. Should a default order be entered against the Respondent, the Board may hold further proceedings it deems appropriate to complete this case without the participation of the Respondent.
