



police officer that over the last couple of weeks, Respondent had to be sent home several times for appearing to be impaired while working;

- b. Respondent admitted to the Asset Protection leader that she stole 25 tablets of Alprazolam and 15 tablets of Lorazepam; and
- c. Respondent also admitted to stealing the tablets in an interview with the police officer. Respondent admitted that she was having a hard time the past couple of weeks.

5. On or about April 11, 2019, Respondent was arrested in the above-mentioned criminal matter. On or about April 12, 2019, Respondent posted bond. Respondent's criminal case is scheduled for a pretrial conference on June 20, 2019.

6. Due to the above facts, Respondent represents a clear and immediate danger to the public health and safety if allowed to continue to practice as a Pharmacy Technician in the State of Indiana.

**WHEREFORE,** Petitioner requests that this Board set a hearing on this petition for summary suspension and suspend the Respondent's license for a period of ninety (90) days and for all other proper relief.
