SUMMARY SUSPENSION ORDER

An administrative hearing was held on April 8, 2013, before the Indiana Board of Pharmacy ("Board") in Room W064 of the Indiana Government Center South, 402 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204, to consider the Petition for Summary Suspension ("Petition") filed against Jessica L. Jackman, P.T.I-T. ("Respondent"), by the State of Indiana ("Petitioner") on April 3, 2013.

The Petitioner was represented by Darren R. Covington, Deputy Attorney General. Respondent failed to appear by person or by counsel.

The Board, pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-4-1 *et seq.* and Ind. Code § 25-1-9-10, by a vote of 6-0-0, **SUMMARILY SUSPENDS** the permit held by Respondent for ninety (90) days, as the Board finds that an emergency exists and that Respondent represents a clear and immediate danger to the public health and safety if allowed to practice pharmacy in the State of Indiana.

This **NON-FINAL** emergency order is based on evidence supporting the following findings:

1. This Board has jurisdiction to suspend Respondent's permit in accordance with the provisions of Ind. Code ch. 4-21.5-4 and Ind. Code § 25-1-9-10.

2. Respondent's address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency is 524 West 42nd Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46208.

3. Respondent is a permitted pharmacy technician in-training in the State of Indiana having been issued license number 99054264A on October 10, 2012.

4. At all times relevant herein, Respondent was employed as a pharmacy technician in-training with CVS Pharmacy ("CVS") in Indianapolis, Indiana.

5. On or around January 3, 2013, CVS reported three separate incidents of theft of prescription narcotics.

6. As a result, CVS fired Respondent for theft, and the Indianapolis Marion County Police Department opened an investigation.

7. On or around February 13, 2013, CVS submitted a DEA Form 106 Report of Theft or Loss of Controlled Substances, which reported about 817 missing hydrocodone tablets, a Class III Controlled Substance.

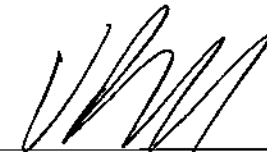
8. On or around March 8, 2013, Respondent was charged in Marion County, Indiana Superior Court with Theft and Possession of a Controlled Substance, both Class D Felonies, under Cause Number 49G14-1303-FD-008564.

WHEREFORE, RESPONDENT IS ORDERED to immediately cease all acts constituting the practice of pharmacy for a period of ninety (90) days, effective April 8, 2013.

ORDERED, this 18 day of April, 2013; this Summary Suspension Order
is effective as of April 8, 2013.
