NOTICE OF PROPOSED DEFAULT ORDER

An administrative hearing was scheduled to be held on April 8, 2013, before the Indiana Board of Pharmacy ("Board") in Room W064 of the Indiana Government Center South, 402 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204, to consider the Complaint filed against Melissa Lexow, C.Ph.T. ("Respondent"), by the State of Indiana ("Petitioner") on March 4, 2013.

The Petitioner was represented by Darren R. Covington, Deputy Attorney General. Respondent failed to appear in person or by counsel.

The Board, pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-24, voted 6-0-0 to issue a Notice of Proposed Default on the following grounds:

1. Respondent's address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency is 15883 Sherman Street, Lowell, Indiana 46356.
2. A Complaint was filed by the Petitioner against Respondent on March 4, 2013.
3. On March 20, 2013, the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency sent a hearing notice to Respondent at her last address of record informing her of the date, time, and place of the administrative hearing on the Complaint scheduled for April 8, 2013, at 2:00 p.m.

4. Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-20, Respondent was provided adequate notice of the hearing and Respondent failed to appear for the scheduled hearing in person or by counsel on April 8, 2013.

NOTICE OF PROPOSED DEFAULT ORDER

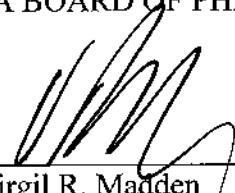
For Respondent's failure to appear for the scheduled hearing, the Board issued the following Notice of Proposed Default:

In accordance with Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-24, Respondent must file a written motion within seven (7) days of service of this Order requesting the Board not enter a default order in this case and stating the reasons relied upon for that request. Failure of Respondent to file such a written motion within seven (7) days shall result in the issuance of a default order. If Respondent timely files a motion, the Board shall consider said motion along with any relevant facts in determining whether a default order should be entered. Should a default order be entered against Respondent, the Board may hold further proceedings it deems appropriate to complete this case without the participation of Respondent.
