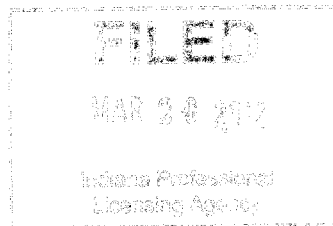

**SUMMARY SUSPENSION ORDER**

An administrative hearing was held on March 12, 2012 before the Indiana Board of Pharmacy (“Board”) in Room W064 of the Indiana Government Center South, 402 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204, to consider the Petition for Summary Suspension (“Petition”) filed against Susan Camille Northrop, R.Ph. (“Respondent”) by the State of Indiana (“Petitioner”) on March 8, 2012.

The State of Indiana was represented by Darren R. Covington, Deputy Attorney General. Respondent failed to appear in person or by counsel.

The Board, pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-4-1 *et seq.* and Ind. Code § 25-1-9-10, by a vote of 6-0-0, **SUMMARILY SUSPENDS** the license held by Susan Camille Northrop, R.Ph. for ninety (90) days as the Board finds that an emergency exists and that Respondent represents a clear and immediate danger to the public health and safety if allowed to practice pharmacy in the State of Indiana.

This **NON-FINAL** emergency order is based on evidence supporting the following findings:

1. This Board has jurisdiction to suspend Respondent’s license in accordance with the provisions of Ind. Code ch. 4-21.5-4 and Ind. Code § 25-1-9-10.

2. Respondent's address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency is 3279 N. Hamilton Road, Mulberry, Indiana 46058.

3. Respondent is a licensed pharmacist in the State of Indiana having been issued license number 26016401A on August 10, 1988.


4. At all times relevant herein, Respondent was employed as a pharmacist with Kroger Pharmacy in Kokomo, Indiana.

5. On or around February 23, 2012, Respondent's employment with Kroger Pharmacy was terminated after Respondent forged prescriptions for phentermine and hydrocodone and diverted phentermine and hydrocodone for her own personal use.

**WHEREFORE, RESPONDENT IS ORDERED** to immediately cease all acts constituting the practice of pharmacy for a period of ninety (90) days, effective March 12, 2012.

**ORDERED**, this 20 day of March, 2012; **this Summary Suspension Order is effective as of March 12, 2012.**

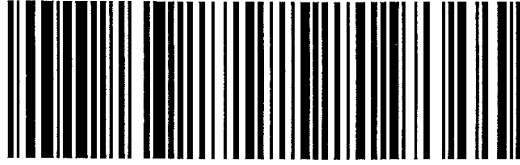
