Carmella M. Dunn, by counsel, hereby withdraws her Motion to Stay and Modify Order. In support hereof, Respondent notifies the Board as follows:

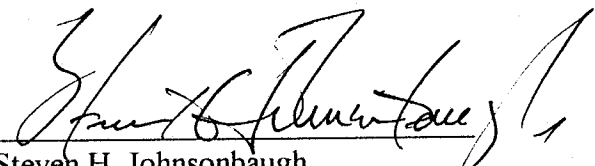
1. Respondent filed a Motion to Stay and Modify Order on or about September 6, 1995, in which she sought a modification and stay of the Board's Findings of Fact and Order of August 15, 1995. Respondent's Motion sought modification of the Findings of Fact and Order on the basis that the terms and conditions of the Order made it impossible for Respondent to work as a pharmacist in any pharmacy under any circumstances and, therefore, amounted to a *de facto* suspension of her pharmacy license. Respondent has not worked as a registered pharmacist since the Board's Order was issued on August 15, 1995.

2. Respondent has suffered a relapse, has provided the Board with written notice of her relapse, and has begun an in-patient treatment program.

3. Respondent hereby withdraws her Motion to Stay and Modify Order.

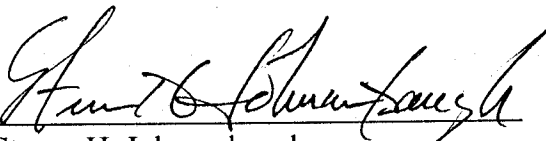
WHEREFORE, Respondent, by counsel, respectfully withdraws her Motion to Stay and Modify Order and for all other proper relief.
