EMERGENCY SUSPENSION ORDER

The Indiana State Board of Pharmacy ("Board") pursuant to the authority of IC 4-21.5-4-1 *et seq.* and IC 25-1-9-10, by a vote of 5 to 0, **SUMMARILY SUSPENDS** the pharmacy license held by Carmella Martin Dunn, R.PH., ("Respondent") for ninety (90) days as the Board finds that an emergency exists and that the Respondent represents a clear and immediate danger to the public health and safety if allowed to continue to practice pharmacy in the State of Indiana.

This **NON-FINAL** emergency order is based upon the Board's review of the evidence during its regularly scheduled meeting on November 13, 1995.

The evidence presented to the Board included written notices from the Respondent and the Respondent's attorney indicating that the Respondent suffered a relapse into the unauthorized use of controlled substances on October 25, 1995,

and that she entered an inpatient treatment program on or about that date, attached and incorporated with this Order as State's Exhibits A and B.

Based upon the above evidence, the Board finds that the Respondent represents a clear and immediate danger to the public health and safety if allowed to continue to practice pharmacy.

WHEREFORE, RESPONDENT IS ORDERED to immediately cease all acts constituting the practice of pharmacy for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of this Order.

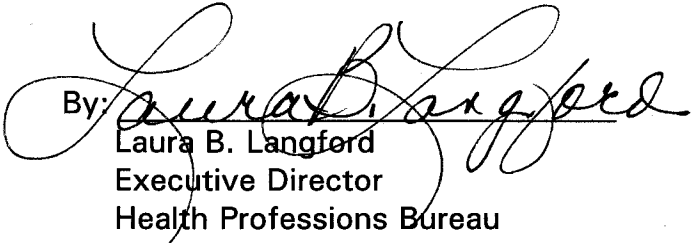
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Respondent shall immediately surrender her pocket license and wall license to the Board in care of the Health Professions Bureau, 402 West Washington Street, Room 041, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204.

Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-4-4, and upon request by the Respondent, the Board shall, as quickly as practicable, set this matter for an evidentiary hearing and an administrative law judge shall determine whether this Order shall be voided, terminated, modified, stayed or continued.
