PETITION FOR SUMMARY SUSPENSION

The State of Indiana ("Petitioner"), by Counsel, Office of the Indiana Attorney General, by Deputy Attorney General Darren R. Covington, moves the Indiana Board of Pharmacy ("Board") to summarily suspend the pharmacy technician license of Kayla A. Powell, C.Ph.T. ("Respondent") for ninety (90) days and in support of its petition states the following:

1. This Board has jurisdiction to suspend Respondent's license in accordance with the provisions of Ind. Code ch. 4-21.5-4 and Ind. Code § 25-1-9-10.
2. Respondent's address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency is 9920 Kramer Court, Indianapolis, Indiana 46235.
3. Respondent is a licensed pharmacy technician in the State of Indiana having been issued license number 67017045A on January 25, 2010.
4. At all times relevant herein, Respondent was employed as a pharmacy technician with Skilled Care Pharmacy.
5. Between August 30, 2012 and September 8, 2012, Skilled Care Pharmacy identified the following losses: 9,739 tablets of hydrocodone; 473 mL of hydrocodone chlorpheniram susp; and 53 tablets of alprazolam.

6. On or around September 8, 2012, Respondent was arrested by the Hamilton County, Indiana Drug Taskforce after video surveillance revealed that Respondent was diverting controlled substances.

7. Respondent was charged in Hamilton County Superior Court 2 with five counts of Theft, a Class D Felony; five counts of Possession of a Controlled Substance, a Class D Felony; and one count of Dealing in a Controlled Substance, a Class B Felony, under Cause Number 29D02-1209-FD-008716.

8. Due to the above facts, Respondent represents a clear and immediate danger to the public health and safety if allowed to continue to practice as a pharmacy technician in Indiana.

WHEREFORE, the State of Indiana requests that this Board set a hearing on this Petition for Summary Suspension and suspend Respondent's license for a period of ninety (90) days and for all other proper relief.


