SUMMARY SUSPENSION EXTENSION ORDER

The Indiana Board of Pharmacy (“Board”) held an administrative hearing on July 13, 2020, by telephone to consider the Petition for Summary Suspension (“Petition”) filed against Terri Robbins, Ph.T., (“Respondent”) by the State of Indiana (“Petitioner”) on December 6, 2019.

Petitioner was represented by Ryan Eldridge, Deputy Attorney General. Respondent failed to appear in person or by counsel.

The Board, pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-4-1 and Ind. Code § 25-1-9-10 and by a vote of 4-0-0, **SUMMARILY SUSPENDS** Respondent’s pharmacy technician license for an additional period of ninety (90) days as the Board finds that an emergency exists and that Respondent represents a clear and immediate danger to the public health and safety if allowed to continue to practice as a pharmacy technician in the State of Indiana.

This **NON-FINAL** emergency order is based on the following evidence:

1. Respondent is a Pharmacy Technician (“Ph.T.”) in the State of Indiana having been issued license number 67026641A by training and education on June 24, 2015.
2. Respondent’s address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency (“IPLA”) is 111 Ruby Court, Michigan City, Indiana 46360.
3. This Board has jurisdiction to suspend Respondent’s license in accordance with the provisions of Ind. Code ch. 4-21.5-4 and Ind. Code § 25-1-9-10.

4. On or about May 5, 2014, Respondent started work at Phil's Healthmart Pharmacy as a Pharmacy Technician.

5. While employed at Phil's Healthmart Pharmacy, Respondent frequently adjusted the perpetual inventory when an order was received for a controlled substance. Respondent then removed controlled substances without authority to do so. Respondent disposed of the altered perpetual inventory sheets after such a transaction.

6. On March 20, 2019, Respondent was caught on surveillance video placing multiple bottles of stock medications into her purse.

7. On or about March 28, 2019, Respondent was terminated from Phil's Healthmart Pharmacy.

8. On or about April 11, 2019, Phil's Healthmart Pharmacy filed a DEA Form 106 for the loss of \$6,710 of controlled substances. This included varying strengths of Oxycodone HCL, Dextroamp-Amphetamin, and Oxycodone-Acetaminophen. The total number of pills lost was approximately 29,700 tablets.

9. Between April 2017 and April 2019, Phil's Healthmart Pharmacy had filed more than twelve (12) DEA Form 106s.

10. IPLA was not notified of the Respondent's actions until October 15, 2019.

11. On December 9, 2019, this Board summarily suspended Respondent's license for ninety (90) days. An extension hearing was set for February 10, 2020.

12. On February 10, 2020, this Board summarily suspended Respondent's license for an additional ninety (90) days. An extension hearing was set for May 11, 2020.

13. On May 11, 2020, this Board summarily suspended Respondent's license for an additional ninety (90) days. An extension hearing was set for July 13, 2020.

14. Due to the above facts, the Respondent represents a clear and immediate danger to the public's health and safety if allowed to continue to practice as a Pharmacy Technician in the State of Indiana.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Respondent's license to practice as a pharmacy technician in the State of Indiana, is hereby summarily suspended for an additional ninety (90) days.

SO ORDERED, this 12th day of August 2020; this Order is effective as of the 13th day of **July 2020**.
